

ORDINANCE 97- 35

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 96-70 COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ORDINANCE. THIS AMENDMENT EXPANDS THE TYPES OF EXPERIENCES THAT ALLOW A PERSON TO QUALIFY FOR THE POSITION OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Florida Ordinance 96-70 is hereby amended by deleting Section 4(c) therefrom and by adding and substituting the following Section 4(c) in its stead:

Section 4(c). Minimum Qualifications: The County Administrator shall, at a minimum, have earned a Bachelor's Degree in Public or Business Administration or related field from an accredited college or university and shall have at least five years of responsible administrative experience in federal, state and/or local government, including agencies or the military or in the private sector, or in any combination thereof. The County Administrator shall have experience in growth management, public utilities, economic development, financing and budgeting, and management of staff.


Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Florida Department of State.

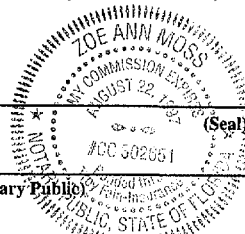
