ORDINANCE NUMBER: 97-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. IOHNS,
STATE OF FLORIDA, REZONING LANDS AS
DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER FROM THE PRESENT
ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CHT, COMMERCIAL
HIGHWAY TOURIST. TO RS-2, SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL
MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT;
REQUIRING RECORDATION;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jeff C. Goodrich, on behalf of William and Barbara Winkler, record title owners, of lands described herein, filed an application for change dated May 6, 1997 for zoning hereinafter described, and after required notice was published a public hearing was held on the 8th day of July, 1997 at 1:30 o'clock PM on said application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- SECTION 1. Upon consideration of the application, R-97-015, supporting documents, statements from the applicant, correspondence received by the Planning Department, recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Agency and comments from the staff and applicant at the public hearing, finds as follows:
  - a. The request for rezoning has been fully considered after public hearing pursuant to legal notice duly published as required by law and the zoning ordinance.
  - b. The proposed rezoning to RS-2 does not adversely affect the orderly development of St. Johns County as embodied in the Zoning Ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan.
  - c. The proposed RS-2 classification will not adversely affect the health and safety of residents or workers in the area and will not be detrimental to the natural environment, development of adjacent properties, or general neighborhood.
  - d. The proposed RS-2 classification will accomplish the objectives, standards and criteria of the Zoning Ordinance.
  - e. The rezoning is consistent with the development of property in the area and is compatible with the desired future development of the area.
  - f. The proposed intensity of development is consistent with the uses allowable by the Comprehensive Plan designation SH-1A.
  - g. On June 5, 1997 the Planning and Zoning Agency held a public hearing on the matter, and has recommended approval by unanimous vote as reflected in its report and recommendation dated June 9, 1997.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the application of Jeff C. Goodrich the zoning classification of CHT, Commercial Highway Tourist, on the following described land:

Boys Work Subdivision, all lot 31, lying west of A1A, as described in the public records of St. Johns County, Florida

is hereby changed to RS-2, Single Family Residential.

SECTION 3. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to impose conditions, limitation or requirements not applicable to all other land in the zoning district wherein said lands are located, except as stated herein.

SECTION 4. All building code, zoning ordinance, and other land use and development regulations of St. Johns County, including, without limitation, the Concurrency Management Ordinance and the St. Johns County Comprehensive Plan, as may be amended from time to time shall be applicable to this development.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by Secretary of State.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be recorded by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in the official records of St. Johns County, Florida, and indexed under the name of property owner listed in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 7. Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the zoning classification shall be recorded on the Zoning Atlas filed in the office of Planning, by the Planning Director or his designee.
