

ORDINANCE 97- 50

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE # 96-70, THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ORDINANCE. THIS AMENDMENT REDUCES THE NUMBER OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER VOTES NEEDED TO APPOINT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:


Section 1. St. Johns County Florida Ordinance # 96-70 is hereby amended by deleting subparagraph b from Section 4 thereof and by adding and substituting the following subparagraph b in its stead:

b. The County Administrator shall be appointed by a majority of the membership of the Board of County Commissioners. The County Administrator may be terminated with cause (after a hearing, if such be requested by the County Administrator,) by a vote of a majority plus one of the membership of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Florida Department of State.



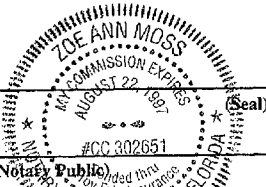
