

ORDINANCE NO. 99- 10

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROHIBITING NON-EMERGENCY PARKING BETWEEN SUNSET AND SUNRISE IN THE COUNTY OWNED RIGHT-OF-WAY ON CANAL BOULEVARD IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, it is found that St. John's County, Florida owns a 60 feet wide right-of-way running approximately 410 feet westerly from Roscoe Boulevard in St. Johns County, Florida, which right-of-way has previously been designated as "Canal Boulevard"; and

WHEREAS, parking of vehicles on said Canal Street between sunset and sunrise has facilitated public nuisance loitering in the area; and

WHEREAS, a restriction on non-emergency parking on said Canal Street between sunset and sunrise shall limit and reduce said public nuisance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY that

1. The above Recitals are incorporated herein as findings of fact.
2. The parking of private vehicles in the county owned right-of-way on Canal Street in St. Johns County in non-emergency situations is hereby prohibited between the time of sunset and sunrise each day.
3. Emergency vehicle parking shall be such proximately caused by the vehicle owner's or legal custodian's good faith effort to prevent bodily harm to an individual or damage to private or public property.
4. The County Administrator is hereby directed to post signs on said Canal Street that will adequately notify the public of parking restrictions established by this Ordinance.
5. Provisions of this Ordinance may be enforced by any method allowed by law or County Ordinance for enforcement of county ordinances. Such provisions shall include, but not be limited, to those code enforcements previously described in Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, and related county ordinances, and those applicable procedures previously adopted for enforcement of traffic and vehicle parking in St. Johns County.

6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its being filed with the Secretary of State of Florida.
