

ORDINANCE 99-44

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE # 96-70, THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ORDINANCE. THIS AMENDMENT AMENDS THE NUMBER OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER VOTES NEEDED TO APPOINT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; AMENDS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WORKING RELATIONSHIPS TO EMPLOYEES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance # 96-70, as previously amended, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph b from Section 4 thereof and by adding and substituting the following paragraph b in its stead:

b. The County Administrator shall be appointed, and may be terminated with cause (after a hearing, if such be requested by the County Administrator), by a vote of a majority plus one of the membership of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance # 96-70, as previously amended, is hereby amended by deleting Section 6. COUNTY COMMISSIONER WORKING RELATIONSHIPS TO EMPLOYEES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR and by adding and substituting the following Section 6 in its stead:

Section 6. COUNTY COMMISSIONER WORKING RELATIONSHIPS TO EMPLOYEES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR. Board instruction or directives to non-legal employees of County government under the jurisdiction and control of the Board of County Commissioners shall be issued only through the County Administrator. A County Commissioner shall not give orders or instructions, publicly or privately, to any County official or employee who is subject to the direction and supervision of the County Administrator. However, interaction, communication and observance will be permitted so long as no direction is given. If a majority of the Board of County Commissioners finds that a County Commissioner has violated this section, the Board may declare the violation an act of misfeasance.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Department of State of Florida.
