

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS ORDINANCE # 86-89, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, TO RATIFY, CLARIFY AND EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO REPLACE, REPAY, OR REIMBURSE COUNTY MONIES, FUNDS AND/OR ACCOUNTS THAT WERE USED TO PAY COSTS OF PROJECTS AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE # 86-89 AS AMENDED, PROVIDED THAT THE COUNTY EXPENDITURES WERE SPENT FOR SUCH COSTS WITHIN 18 MONTHS OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS ; MAKING FINDINGS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance 86-89, as previously amended, the County's home rule ordinance authorizing the County to issue bonds for capital projects, does not expressly confer authority to issue bonds to repay or replace prior County expenditures that were made to pay costs of such projects ; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, (the "Board" ) considers it desirable and appropriate to amend ordinance 86-89 to clarify that ordinance 86-89 does, in fact, confer authority to issue bonds for such purposes and to ratify and expressly authorize the issuance of such bonds,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ( the "Board" ) as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds, determines and declares that there have been and will be times when a County purpose is served by using monies in the County reserve fund or other currently available County monies to pay Costs of Projects and then issuing Bonds to repay or replace those monies.

Section 2. The Board hereby clarifies and amends St. Johns County ordinance 86-89, as previously amended, by adding the following section 9 thereto:

Section 9. The foregoing sections shall be deemed to authorize the Board to issue Bonds to replace, repay, and/or reimburse County monies, funds and accounts that were used to pay Costs of Projects provided that the County monies, funds and accounts that will be replaced, repaid or reimbursed with Bond proceeds were spent or used to pay Costs of those Projects within 18 months prior to the issuance of the Bonds or within such later time as permitted by Treasury Regulations section 1.150-2, as amended from time to time,

relating to the issuance of tax exempt obligations. This section is intended to clarify County ordinance 86-89 as originally enacted and, as such, shall be deemed to have been included in ordinance 86-89 when the ordinance was originally enacted. The County's issuance of Bonds for such purpose is ratified, clarified and expressly authorized.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon a certified copy thereof being filed with the Florida Department of State.
