

ORDINANCE NO: 2000- 54

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATED TO EMPLOYEES' DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLANS; AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 85-20 BY ALLOWING THE SHERIFF, TAX COLLECTOR, PROPERTY APPRAISER, CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT, AND SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS, AND THEIR EMPLOYEES, TO PARTICIPATE IN DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLANS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY; RATIFYING AND APPROVING ANY PREVIOUS PARTICIPATION BY SAID CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS IN ANY OF THE PLANS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; DESIGNATING A COUNTY OFFICIAL TO MAKE THE DETERMINATIONS PERTAINING TO SUCH PLANS REQUIRED BY SECTION 112.215 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance 85-20 authorizes deferred compensation plans for the benefit of the employees of the County;

WHEREAS, allowing employees to build supplemental retirement income by participating in deferred compensation plans enhances attracting and retaining competent personnel;

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the employees of the Sheriff, Tax Collector, Property Appraiser, Clerk of the Circuit Court, and Supervisor of Elections participate in deferred compensation plans authorized by the County;

WHEREAS, Section 112.215 of the Florida Statutes requires that a public official be designated to make certain determinations pertaining to the income and tax status of deferred compensation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 85-20 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 7 to read as follows:

Section 7. The Sheriff, Tax Collector, Property Appraiser, Clerk of the Circuit Court, Supervisor of Elections, and their respective employees, may, at their option, participate in any of the existing employees' deferred compensation plans authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, and may also participate in any plans hereafter authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County. Any

previous participation before the date of this amending Ordinance by said constitutional officers in any of the plans established by the Board of County Commissioners is hereby ratified and approved.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 85-20 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 8 to read as follows:

Section 8. The County Administrator, or his designee, for the Board of County Commissioners is designated to make the determinations pertaining to employees' deferred compensation plans required by Section 112.215(6) of the Florida Statutes.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon a certified copy thereof being filed with the Department of State of the State of Florida.

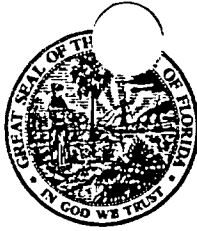

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 10, 2000 at 1:30 p.m. in the County Auditorium at the County Administration Complex, 4020 Lewis Speedway (County Road 16-A) and U.S. 1 North, St. Augustine, Florida, to consider adoption of the following ordinance: AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATED TO EMPLOYEES DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLANS; AMENDING ST. Interested parties may appear at the public hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the public hearing, he/she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he/she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
