

ORDINANCE NO. 2001- 64

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING, ADDING AND REPEALING SECTIONS OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 99-51, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED; THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS ARTICLE XII DEFINITIONS, REVISING PART 12.01.00 DEFINITIONS, SPECIFICALLY REVISING THE DEFINITION OF FLAG, REVISING THE DEFINITION OF LOT OF RECORD, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of **Flag** contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

Flag: A piece of cloth or similar material having a distinctive size, color, and design used as a symbol, standard, signal and other similar items of recognition and may include insignias of governmental, religious, charitable, fraternal or other organizations. Any Flag and pole or attachment that frequently holds a Flag shall be deemed a permanent Flag. This definition of Flag shall exclude the Flag of the United States of America.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of **Lot of Record** contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

Lot of Record: Means:

- A. A Lot which is part of a subdivision which has been recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County, or
- B. A Lot or Parcel described by metes and bounds, the description of which has been so recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of St. Johns County consistent with the Land Development Regulations in effect at that time.
- C. A Lot or Parcel described by metes and bounds, the division of which complies with the Land Development Regulations in effect on the date of conveyance creating the division as evidenced by reasonably reliable documentation substantiating such conveyance.

Section 3. Severance Clause. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, and is hereby provided, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon being filed with the Department of State of Florida.

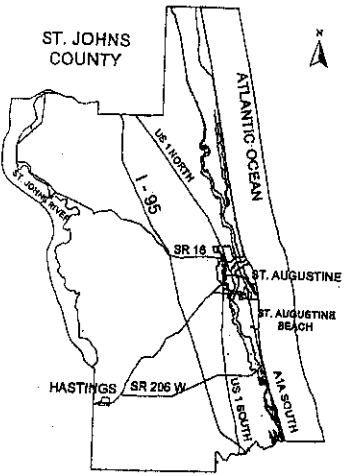

If a person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at the hearings, such person will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose he/she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

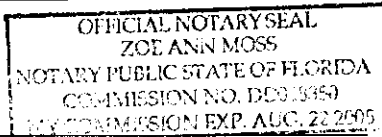
