

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-06

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REPEALING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 70-2, AS AMENDED, WHICH IS AN OUT OF DATE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION, APPROVAL AND LICENSING OF CHILD CARE CENTERS BY THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board"), hereby finds and determines the following:

A. On March 24, 1970, the Board enacted St. Johns County Ordinance 70-2 which required Child Care Centers to be licensed and inspected by the St. Johns County Health Department.

B. Subsequent to that time, State laws have been changed whereby the Florida Department of Children and Family Services has assumed more and more responsibility for the licensing and regulation of homes and facilities that care for children who are unrelated to the owner or operator of the home or facility.

C. As a consequence, St. Johns County Ordinance 70-2, as amended, fell into disuse and became obsolete.

D. It is appropriate that St. Johns County Ordinance 70-2, as amended, be repealed in order to avoid confusion with the requirements and policies of Chapter 402, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance 70-2, as amended, is hereby repealed.

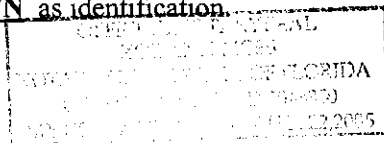
