

ORDINANCE 02-24

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF ANNUAL PREPAID PASSES AT THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY GOLF COURSE. TO ESTABLISH A FEE STRUCTURE AND AUTHORIZE THE GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT TO SELL PREPAID PASSES. PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Golf Course previously issued family and individual prepaid passes and these original pass holders are still eligible to renew those passes; and

WHEREAS, the number of active pass holders has dropped to approximately one hundred; and

WHEREAS, the present bond payment schedule places a temporary burden on course revenues; and

WHEREAS, the sale of family and individual prepaid passes would provide a significant fiscal advantage to course revenues as well as reducing the cost of rounds to regular course players; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Recreation Advisory Board, at their March 13, 2002, meeting has approved a resolution recommending that the Board of County Commissioners consider the selling of prepaid passes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

1. Authorize the Golf Course Superintendent to sell individual and family annual passes at the St. Johns County Golf Course.
2. Establish the annual pass rates as: Individual, \$866.25 plus tax; Family, \$1,328.25 plus tax; Student, \$220.50 plus tax.
3. Provide for a one-time pro rata fee for Fiscal Year 2002.
4. This Ordinance shall become effective on the first day of May, 2002.

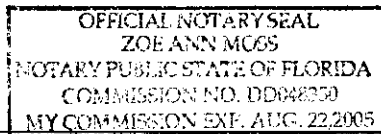

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 9, 2002 at 1:30 p.m. in the County Auditorium at the County Administration Complex, 4020 Lewis Speedway (County Road 16-A) and U.S.1 North, St. Augustine, Florida, to consider adoption of the following ordinance:
