AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING, ADDING AND REPEALING SECTIONS OF ARTICLE XII OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 99-51, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED; THIS ORDINANCE MAKES CHANGES INCLUDING AND RELATING TO: AMENDING PART 12.01.00 DEFINITIONS; SPECIFICALLY REVISING THE DEFINITION OF BOARDING HOUSE: REVISING THE DEFINITION OF HOTEL, MOTEL, MOTOR LODGE, OR TOURIST COURT; REVISING THE DEFINITION OF MANUFACTURED/MODULAR HOME; REVISING THE **DEFINITION** OF MANUFACTURED/MOBILE PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of **Boarding House** contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

Boarding or Rooming House: An establishment with lodging for four or more persons, where meals are regularly prepared and served for compensation and where food is placed upon the table family style, without service or ordering of individual portions from a menu. In addition, Single Family Dwellings in which sleeping accommodations are offered to four or more unrelated persons for rentals of one week or more, and occupancy is generally by residents rather than transients, shall be considered a Boarding or Rooming House. Boarding or Rooming Houses shall be allowed in those zoning districts designated for Special Care Housing.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of **Hotel, Motor Hotel, Motor Lodge, or Tourist Court** contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

Hotel, Motel, Motor Hotel, Motor Lodge, or Tourist Court: A Building or a group of Buildings in which sleeping accommodations are offered to the public and intended primarily for rental to transients with daily charge, as distinguished from Multiple Family Dwellings and Boarding or Rooming Houses, where rentals are for periods of one week or more and occupancy is generally by residents rather than transients.

Section 3. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of Manufactured/Modular Home contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

> Manufactured/Modular Home: A Manufactured/Modular Building used for residential purposes.

Section 4. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by replacing the definition of Manufactured/Mobile Home contained in Part 12.01.00 thereof with the following:

> Manufactured/Mobile Home: A residential Dwelling Unit constructed to standards promulgated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 5. Severance Clause. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, and is hereby provided, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon being filed with the Department of State of Florida.




