ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2004-61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, REZONING LANDS AS DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER FROM THE PRESENT ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF OPEN RURAL (OR) TO SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RS-2); MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; REQUIRING RECORDATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, Robert Hahnemann, the owner of lands described herein, incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A" (legal description), filed an application, incorporated by reference as File Number REZ 2004-03 for a zoning change dated January 26, 2004, as described hereinafter, and after required notice was published, a public hearing was held on the 27th day of July, 2004 at 1:30 p.m. on said application.

SECTION 1. Upon consideration of the application, supporting documents, statements from the applicant, correspondence received by the Growth Management Services Department, recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Agency, and comments from the staff and the general public at the public hearing, finds as follows:

1. The request for rezoning has been fully considered after public hearing with legal notice duly published as required by law.
2. The rezoning to Single Family Residential (RS-2) is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, in that:
  - (a) The rezoning is compatible and complementary to adjacent land uses. (Objective A.1.3)
  - (b) The rezoning encourages an efficient and compact land use pattern and supports balanced growth. (Objective A.1.11)
3. The rezoning to Single Family Residential (RS-2) is consistent with the St. Johns County Land Development Code.
4. The zoning district designation of Single Family Residential (RS-2) is consistent with the land uses allowed in the land use designation of Residential B (RES-B) as depicted on the 2015 Future Land Use Map.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to this application File Number REZ 2004-03 the zoning classification of the lands described within the legal description, Exhibit "A",

is hereby changed to Single Family Residential (RS-2).

SECTION 3. To the extent that they do not conflict with the unique, specific and detailed provisions of this

Ordinance, all provisions of the Land Development Code as such may be amended from time to time shall be applicable to development of property referenced herein except to the degree that development may qualify for vested rights in accordance with applicable ordinances and laws. Notwithstanding any provision of this ordinance, no portion of any concurrency provision or impact fee ordinance, building code, Comprehensive Plan or any other non Land Development Code ordinance or regulation shall be deemed waived or varied by any provision herein.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by the Secretary of State.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be recorded in a book kept and maintained by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in accordance with Section 125.68, Florida Statutes.

**SECTION 6.** Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the zoning classification shall be recorded on the Zoning Atlas filed maintained in the Growth Management Services Department by the Planning Director or designee.

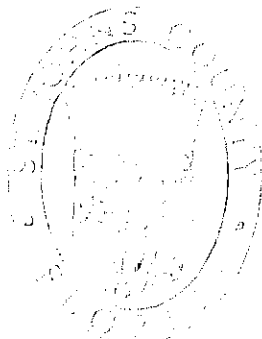

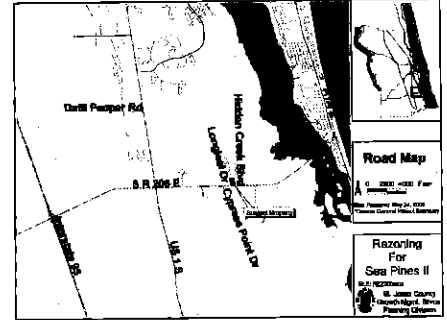
