

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-71

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 3.01.02 OF ARTICLE III OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 99-51, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED; THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS SECTION 3.01.02 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO DELETE POSITIONS OF TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS AND ADD FOUR FULL PARTICIPATING AT-LARGE POSITIONS IN THEIR PLACE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance # 99-51, as previously amended, is hereby amended by deleting Section 3.01.02.A.1 in its entirety and by adding and substituting the following Section 3.01.02.A.1 in its stead:


A. Membership and Procedures

1. The HRRB shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners with representation from each of the five (5) County Commission Districts and four (4) at-large members, when reasonably possible. Members shall be appointed for a four-year term, except for an appointment to fill an unexpired term, in which event, the appointment shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term only.


Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its being filed with the Department of State of Florida.
