

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DISSOLVING THE JULINGTON CREEK MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING DISTRICT (MSTD) PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 82-17; PROVIDING FOR DISBURSEMENT OF ANY AND ALL FUNDS HELD BY THE COUNTY IN THE ACCOUNTS OF SAID "MSTD" TO BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FOR USE OF CERTAIN LIMITED PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Municipal Service Taxing District ("MSTD" or "Taxing District") was established in the year 1982 by St. Johns County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by enactment of Ordinance 82-17; and

WHEREAS, said Taxing District has not assessed nor collected taxes since FY 1993 because it's functions have been assumed by other government agencies; and

WHEREAS, said Taxing District has only approximately \$1584.00 in its current account.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:


1. The Julington Creek Municipal Taxing District created by St. Johns County Ordinance 82-17 is hereby dissolved effective September 30, 2005.


2. Any and all funds held in the account of said Taxing District that have not previously been committed to other purposes shall be transferred to the General Revenue Fund of St. Johns County as of the date of the dissolution of said Taxing District, from which such funds shall only be expended for municipal purposes as would have been authorized for such funds had they remained in the accounts of said Taxing District.


3. This ordinance shall take effect upon a certified copy being filed with the Department of State of Florida.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2005, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Auditorium at the County Administration Complex, 4020 Lewis Speedway (County Road 16-A) and U.S. 1 North, St. Augustine, Florida, to consider adoption of the following proposed ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DISSOLVING THE JULINGTON CREEK MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING DISTRICT (MSTO), PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2001, PROVIDING FOR DISBURSEMENT OF ANY AND ALL FUNDS HELD BY THE COUNTY IN THE ACCOUNTS OF SAID DISTRICT, AND BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FOR USE OF CERTAIN LIMITED PURPOSES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The proposed ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners at the St. Johns County Administration Complex, 4020 Lewis Speedway (CR 16A and U.S. #1), St. Augustine, Florida, and may be examined by parties interested prior to the public hearing. Interested parties may appear at the public hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance.

If a person wishes to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the public hearing, he/she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he/she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
