AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, REZONING LANDS AS DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER THE **PRESENT** ZONING FROM CLASSIFICATION OF PLANNED SPECIAL DEVELOPMENT (PSD) TO OPEN RURAL(OR); MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; REQUIRING RECORDATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, the development of the lands within this rezoning shall proceed in accordance with the application, dated November 03, 2009 in addition to supporting documents and statements from the applicant which are a part of Zoning File REZ 2009-14 Anastasia Baptist Church at SR16 Rezoning, as approved by the Board of County Commissioners, and incorporated by reference into and made part hereof this Ordinance. In the case of conflict between the application, the supporting documents, and the below described special provisions of this Ordinance, the below described provisions shall prevail.

SECTION 1. Upon consideration of the application, supporting documents, statements from the applicant, correspondence received by the Growth Management Services Department, recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Agency, and comments from the staff and the general public at the public hearing, the Board of County Commissioners, finds as follows:

- 1. The request for rezoning has been fully considered after public hearing with legal notice duly published as required by law.
- 2. The rezoning to Open Rural (OR) is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, in that:
 - (a) The rezoning is compatible and complementary to adjacent land uses. (Objective A.1.3.12)
 - (b) The rezoning encourages an efficient and compact land use pattern and supports balanced growth and economic development. (Objective A.1.11)
 - (c) The proposed project is consistent with the goals, policies and objectives of the 2015 St. Johns County Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. The rezoning to Open Rural (OR) is consistent with the St. Johns County Land Development Code.
- 4. The zoning district designation of Open Rural (OR) is consistent with the land uses allowed in the land use designation of Mixed Use District as depicted on the 2015 Future Land Use Map.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to this application File Number REZ 2009-14 the zoning classification of the lands described within the attached legal description, Exhibit "A",

is hereby changed to Open Rural (OR).

SECTION 3. To the extent that they do not conflict with the unique, specific and detailed provisions of this Ordinance, all provisions of the Land Development Code as such may be amended from time to time shall be applicable to development of property referenced herein except to the degree that development may qualify for vested rights in accordance with applicable ordinances and laws. Notwithstanding any provision of this ordinance, no portion of any concurrency provision or impact fee ordinance, building code, Comprehensive Plan or any other non Land Development Code ordinance or regulation shall be deemed waived or varied by any provision herein.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by the Secretary of State.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be recorded in a book kept and maintained by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in accordance with Section 125.68, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 6. Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the zoning classification shall be recorded on the Zoning Atlas filed maintained in the Growth Management Services Department by the Planning Director or designee.







SCHEDULE "B"

AND further to have and to hold said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, estate, title and interest thereto, belonging to the ST. AUGUSTINE BAPTIST CHURCH, INCORPORATED, a nonpression, its successors and assigns, forever, for the use and benefit of those of the membership, even shough they may be a minority, who adhere to, maintain and propagate the doctrines, shith and practices of the missionary Baptist churches which cooperate with the Florida Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention, and failure or refusal of the membership of said church, even though they be a majority, to adhere to, maintain and propagate the doctrines, faith and practices of missionary Baptist Convention, and the Southern Baptist Convention, shall constitute such deviation from the escepted usages, practices and beliefs of Baptists, that said majority shall no longer constitute the true congregation of said church, the title to the property hereinabove described shall vest in, and be held for, the use and benefit of the minority who do adhere to, maintain and propagate the doctrines, faith and practices of the members of missionary Baptist churches which cooperate with the Florida Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention; and, in the event the entire membership or the ST. AUGUSTINE BAPTIST CHURCH INCORPORATED, should fail or refuse to follow, or should renounce the doctrines, faith and practices of members of Baptist churches which cooperate with said Conventions, then the title of the above described property shall revest to and become vested in the Florida Baptist Convention, or its successor, to be used for church and mission purposes.

Upon rendering the annual account at the end of each fiscal year and its acceptance and approval by the church, the records shall be delivered by the treasurer to the church clerk, who shall keep and preserve the account as a part of the permanent records of the church. The treasurer shall also be responsible to see that everyone who has given money or things of value to the church receives an annual statement of contributions after the close of the calendar year.

f. The church shall elect three or more TRUSTEES to serve as legal officers for the church.

Upon a specific vote of the church sutherizing each action, they shall have the power to buy, sell, mortgage, lease, of transfer any church property. When the signatures of trustees are required, they shall sign legal documents involving the sale, martgage, purchase, or sental of property, or other legal documents related to church approved matters.

Trustees shall serve on a rotation basis, with one new trustee being elected each year. A trustee must waik one year hefore being elected to some another texts.

g. The church shall elect DEACONS by ballot at regular business meetings of the church. There shall be one deacon elected for assigned service for every twelve to fifteen church resident families.


Deacons shall serve on a rotation basis. Each program year the assigned term of office of one third of the number of deacons shall expire, and election shall be held to fill vacancies and to add to the deacons such numbers as the church size warrants. The church nominating committee shall nominate one name for each opening. The pastor and the chairman of deacons will visit. If willing and meets the Biblical requirements one name for each opening will be presented to the church in business meeting for vote. In case of death or removal or incapacity to serve, the church may elect a deacon to fill the unexpired term, using the same procedure. After serving a term of three years assignment, a deacon shall be eligible for reelection only after the lapse of at least one year. There shall be no obligation to constitute as a assigned deacon, one who has been a deacon, his previous optimation by another church of like faith and order shall suffice for this church.

In accordance with the meaning of the work and the practice in the New Testament, descons are to be servents of the church. Their task is to serve with the pastor and staff in performing the pastoral ministries tasks of (1) leading the church in the achievement of its mission (2) proclaiming the gospel to believers and unbelievers, and (3) caring for the church's members and other persons in the community. Descons shall serve as the church benevolence committee.
