

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-60

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; REPEALING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2017-59; DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COURT TO REMOVE THE REPEALED ORDINANCE FROM THE COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY:

**Section 1. Findings of Fact.**

The Board of County Commissioners (the Board) makes the following findings of fact in support of this ordinance:

A. On December 19, 2017, the Board enacted St. Johns County Ordinance 2017-59, which established the Ponte Vedra and Vilano Beaches Dune and Beach Municipal Service Taxing Units (the MSTUs).

B. Section 4 of Ordinance 2017-59 provided that in the event the Board did not levy millage in at least one of the MSTUs established by the Ordinance in 2018, staff was directed to bring an ordinance to the Board repealing the ordinance and the MSTUs created therein.

C. The Board did not levy a millage in any of the MSTUs established by Ordinance 2017-59 in its Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget.

**Section 2. Repeal of Ordinance.**

The Board hereby repeals St. Johns County Ordinance 2017-59 and the MSTUs created therein in their entirety. The Clerk of Court is directed to remove Ordinance 2017-59 from the County Code and to place it in the Clerk's compilation of repealed ordinances.

**Section 3. Severability.**

If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remainder of this ordinance.

**Section 4. Effective Date.**

This ordinance shall be effective upon a certified copy being filed with the Florida Department of State.


