ORDINANCE BOARD OF AN \mathbf{BY} THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A SLOW SPEED MINIMUM WAKE BOATING RESTRICTED AREA WITHIN A PORTION OF PABLO CREEK; **PROVIDING** FINDINGS: **PROVIDING DEFINITIONS**; PROVIDING FOR PROHIBITIONS AND EXEMPTIONS: PROVIDING FOR THE PERMITTING, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 327.46(1)(b), Florida Statutes authorizes counties to establish certain boating-restricted areas, by ordinance, on waterways of the state, including portions of the Florida Intracoastal Waterway (ICW) within their jurisdiction, including slow speed, minimum wake boating restricted areas if such areas are within 300 feet of a bridge span presenting a vertical clearance of less than 25 feet or a horizontal clearance of less than 100 feet; and

WHEREAS, within St. Johns County the San Pablo Road Bridge spans Pablo Creek, a tributary of the ICW; and

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Road Bridge at Pablo Creek has a vertical clearance of less than 25 feet and a horizontal clearance of less than 100 feet; and

WHEREAS, the prudent and safe operation of vessels is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, a slow speed minimum wake boating-restricted area on Pablo Creek at the San Pablo Road Bridge is necessary to avoid navigational and safety hazards to persons and damage to property resulting from vessels traveling under and in the vicinity of the bridge.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- **Section 1.** Findings. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners and incorporated and made a part of this Ordinance.
- **Section 2.** <u>Definitions.</u> For purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:
 - (1) Person means an individual, partnership, firm corporation, association, or other entity.
- (2) Slow Speed, Minimum Wake indicates a boating restricted area which has been established to protect the safety of the public. Slow Speed Minimum Wake means that a vessel must be fully off plane and completely settled into the water. It may not proceed at a speed greater than that speed which is reasonable and prudent to avoid the creation of an excessive wake or other hazardous condition under the existing circumstances. A vessel that is:

- (a) Operating on a plane is not proceeding at slow speed minimum wake;
- (b) In the process of coming off plane and settling into the water or coming up onto plane is not proceeding at slow speed minimum wake;
- (c) Operating at a speed that creates a wake which unreasonably or unnecessarily endangers other vessels is not proceeding at slow speed minimum wake;
- (d) Completely off plane and which has fully settled into the water and is proceeding without wake or with minimum wake, is proceeding at slow speed minimum wake.
- (3) Vessel means any boat, vessel, or watercraft being propelled or powered by machinery including but not limited to personal watercraft.
- (4) Wake means all changes in the vertical height of the water surface caused by the passage of a vessel, including but no limited to, a vessel's bow wake, stern wake, and propeller wash.
- Section 3. San Pablo Road Bridge Slow Speed Minimum Wake Boating Restricted Area. All waters lying within and adjacent to Pablo Creek, from shoreline to shoreline, from a line drawn perpendicular to the centerline of Pablo Creek 300 feet northeast of the San Pablo Road Bridge to a line drawn perpendicular to the centerline of Pablo Creek 300 feet southwest of said bridge as depicted on attached Exhibit A.
- Section 4. <u>Prohibitions.</u> It shall be unlawful for any Person in physical control of a Vessel in the Slow Speed Minimum Wake Boating Restricted Area to operate the Vessel in a manner in violation of this Ordinance.
- Section 5. Exemptions. The restrictions created by this Ordinance shall not apply to Vessels of any federal, state, county, or municipal agency while operated by an officer, employee, or agent thereof who is engaged in law enforcement or other necessary municipal or governmental activity.
- Section 6. Signs. To ensure slow speeds, minimum wakes in the boating restricted area, signs necessary for implementing this Ordinance must be permitted, installed, and maintained as required by sections 327.40 and 327.41, F.S. The Department of Parks and Recreation shall design and obtain necessary permits to install up to four signs, at appropriate locations to alert the boating public about the existence and boundaries of the Slow Speed, Minimum Wake area. All signs shall comply with the standards and regulations required by state law. No Person shall be charged with a violation of this Ordinance prior to the posting of signs as required by this Section.
- **Section 7.** Enforcement. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office and deputies thereof, the Di vision of Law Enforcement of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and its officers, and any other authorized law enforcement officer as provided for in section 327.70, F. S.
- Section 8. <u>Penalties.</u> Any Person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be charged with a noncriminal infraction by a boating citation, and shall be subject to other procedures and penalties set forth in section 327.73, F. S. and other applicable provisions of chapter 327 of the Florida

Statutes, as it may be amended from time to time.

Section 9. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the filing of this Ordinance with the office of the Department of State of Florida.


