#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-6**

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS; AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2008-29 REGARDING THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING **ADVISORY** COMMITTEE, SPECIFICALLY THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS SECTION 3 (COMPOSITION OF THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE), ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2008-29 TO MODIFY THE COMPOSITION OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 420.9076, FLORIDA STATUTES: ADDRESSING BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE REQUIRED BY SECTION 125.66, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### RECITALS

**WHEREAS**, as required by section 420.9072, Florida Statutes, on or about May 27, 2008, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida ("Board") enacted Ordinance 2008-29 to create the St. Johns County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee as a provided in section 420.9076, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) is charged with recommending incentives and strategies for affordable housing in St. Johns County under the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) program in accordance with section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, as amended; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to section 420.9076, Florida Statutes requires that the membership of the all affordable housing advisory committees include a locally elected official and clarifies membership requirements for the remaining members; and

**WHEREAS,** to comply with state law, the County must amend Section 3 (Composition of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee), St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2008-29; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 125.66, Florida Statutes a business impact estimate is not required for ordinances required to comply with state law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds this amendment is necessary to conform to state law and is in the best interest of the County; now, therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

**Section 1. Findings.** The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners and incorporated and made a part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** Amending Ordinance No. 2008-29. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2008-29 is hereby amended to amend Section 3 (Composition of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee) to read as follows:

## Ordinance No. 2008-29

#### Section 3. Composition of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee.

Pursuant to, and in accordance with, Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, <u>as amended</u>, the composition of the AHAC must consist of one current member of the Board of County Commissioners and one representative from at least six of the following categories:

- a) A citizen who is actively engaged in the residential home building industry in connection with affordable housing.;
- b) A citizen who is actively engaged in the banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing.;
- c) A citizen who is a representative of those areas of labor actively engaged in home building in connection with affordable housing.;
- d) A citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing.;
- e) A citizen who is actively engaged as a for-profit provider of affordable housing.;
- f) A citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing.;
- g) A citizen who is actively engaged as a real estate professional in connection with affordable housing.;
- h) A citizen who actively serves on the local planning agency pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes.;
- i) A citizen who resides within the jurisdiction of the local governing body making appointments.;

- j) A citizen who represents employers within the jurisdiction.;
- k) A citizen who represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan.
- Section 3. Business Impact Estimate. This Ordinance is required to comply with section 420.9076, Florida Statutes; therefore, a business impact estimate is not required pursuant to section 125.66(3)(c)1., Florida Statutes.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effective upon a certified copy being filed with the Florida Department of State.
