

RESOLUTION 85- 106

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA
DECLARING ST. JOHNS COUNTY SUBJECT TO THE
PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 367 FLORIDA STATUTES.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida has determined that the regulation of water and sewer systems in St. Johns County requires expertise and increased staff not currently available; and,

WHEREAS the County has determined that potential revenues from said regulation would not be sufficient to offset regulatory costs incurred; and,


WHEREAS Section 367.171, Florida Statutes, provides for the transfer of water and sewer system regulatory authority to the Florida Public Service Commission by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that St. Johns County is subject to the provisions of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes, and that all water and sewer systems within the County that meet the definition of "utility" as defined by Florida Statutes 367.021 are subject to the jurisdiction and regulatory authority of the Florida Public Service Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk shall immediately notify the Public Service Commission of the adoption of this resolution and shall mail a certified copy of this resolution to the Public Service Commission forthwith.
