

RESOLUTION 85- 125

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY REQUESTING THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO INITIATE AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE RATES OF ST. AUGUSTINE SHORES UTILITIES (DELTONA CORPORATION) BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE OVER EARNINGS OCCASSIONED BY ITS RECENT IMPLEMENTATION OF A SUBSTANTIAL RATE INCREASE.

WHEREAS, on or about June 19, 1985, St. Augustine Shores Utilities Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Deltona") mailed its petition to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County requesting the County to approve its requested water and sewer rate increases for its customers in St. Johns County Florida; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 25, 1985 the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County passed its Resolution 85-106 transferring its water and sewer utility rate determination jurisdiction to the Florida Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, Deltona has recently implemented its requested rate increases without final review by either the County or the Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the rate increase is very substantial and the County has received many objections and expressions of opposition to the increase from the Utility's customers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 24th day of September, 1985 by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County as follows:

1. The Florida Public Service Commission is requested to immediately initiate an investigation into the increased water and sewer rates

charged by St. Augustine Shores Utilities (Deltona) to its customers within St. Johns County Florida.
