NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has no objection to and endorses the location and building of a Crisis Stabilization Unit in Palatka; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be sent to the Interim Executive Director of Tri-County Mental Health so that it may become a part of their package in requesting financial assistance for the building of this project.
