

RESOLUTION NO. 85- 141

A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, INCREASING THE FEE FOR WHICH THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FOR CERTIFIED COPIES OF BIRTH AND DEATH RECORDS.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance No. 82-2 authorized St. Johns County Health Department to collect reasonable fees, contributions and donations for certain services performed by the Health Department upon approval of such fee by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, HB 1358 (1985) now requires that \$2.50 be forwarded to the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services for each request for certified birth certificates or birth records.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8 day of October, 1985, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that St. Johns County Resolutions #82-59 is hereby amended by changing the Schedule A fee schedule attached to said resolution to require \$4.00 for birth certificates instead of \$3.00 and to require \$4.00 for death certificates instead of \$3.00.

All other provisions of St. Johns County Resolution 82-59, as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
