THIS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZES THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AN APPLICATION FOR A RECREATIONAL GRANT ADDRESSED TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROGRAM; AUTHORIZES USE OF MATCHING COUNTY FUNDS; CONFIRMS THAT THE FACILITY HAS THE FULL FAITH AND BACKING OF THE PEOPLE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY; DEDICATES THE FACILITIES' USE TO FLORIDIANS AND ALL STATE VISITORS; PROVIDES RECREATION IN A VERY LOW INCOME AREA WHICH IS IN GREAT NEED OF A RECREATIONAL FACILITY; WILL GREATLY IMPROVE ACCESS OF RECREATION TO THE PUBLIC; AND AUTHORIZES THE DEVELOPMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE FACILITY KNOWN AS RAVENSWOOD COMMUNITY PARK by St. Johns County.

Whereas, the County of St. Johns has prepared a grant application for the development of an outdoor recreation facility at Ravenswood Community Park under the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund Program; and

Whereas, it is required that a Resolution be adopted and become an official part of the application; and

Now, therefore be it resolved by the Chairman and the Board of County Commissioners, County of St. Johns, Florida, as follows:

- 1. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to present an application requesting grant funds to the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund for development of a recreational facility at Ravenswood Community Park.
- 2. That the County Administrator or his designee is hereby designated the official liaison agent.
- 3. That the County of St. Johns is hereby requesting grant funds from the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund in the amount of \$150,000.00.
- 4. That the amount of matching fund required, \$150,000.00, is hereby appropriated from the County Recreational Funds in the form of cash, in-kind services, equipment rental, material and/or labor. This amount shall be available until this project is completed.

- That the total cost of this phase of developing the project site shall be \$300,000.00.
- That St. Johns County is legally capable and fiscally able to satisfactorily develop, operate and maintain the facility according to program requirements.
- 7.1 That the County of St. Johns, Florida, has an Local Comprehensive Plan, officially adopted including a Recreation and Open Space Element with the public being continuously offered the opportunity to participate in the process.
- 7.2 That the County of St. Johns certifies that the development of this project site will be a positive step in attaining the recreational goals by the Local Comprehensive Plan for this area in particular and the County over all.
- 8. That this project is in compliance with and is a step toward fulfillment of the goals of the Local Plan as shown elsewhere in this application.
- 9. This Resolution shall be in effect as prescribed by law upon its passage.
