

RESOLUTION NO. 85-188

THIS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZES THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AN APPLICATION FOR A RECREATIONAL GRANT ADDRESSED TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROGRAM; AUTHORIZES USE OF MATCHING COUNTY FUNDS; CONFIRMS THAT THE FACILITY HAS THE FULL FAITH AND BACKING OF THE PEOPLE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY; DEDICATES THE FACILITIES' USE TO FLORIDIANS AND ALL STATE VISITORS; PROVIDES RECREATION IN A VERY LOW INCOME AREA WHICH IS IN GREAT NEED OF A RECREATIONAL FACILITY; WILL GREATLY IMPROVE ACCESS OF RECREATION TO THE PUBLIC; AND AUTHORIZES THE DEVELOPMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE FACILITY KNOWN AS RAVENSWOOD COMMUNITY PARK by St. Johns County.

Whereas, the County of St. Johns has prepared a grant application for the development of an outdoor recreation facility at Ravenswood Community Park under the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund Program; and

Whereas, it is required that a Resolution be adopted and become an official part of the application; and

Now, therefore be it resolved by the Chairman and the Board of County Commissioners, County of St. Johns, Florida, as follows:

1. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to present an application requesting grant funds to the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund for development of a recreational facility at Ravenswood Community Park.
2. That the County Administrator or his designee is hereby designated the official liaison agent.
3. That the County of St. Johns is hereby requesting grant funds from the Florida Land and Water Conservation Fund in the amount of \$150,000.00.
4. That the amount of matching fund required, \$150,000.00, is hereby appropriated from the County Recreational Funds in the form of cash, in-kind services, equipment rental, material and/or labor. This amount shall be available until this project is completed.

5. That the total cost of this phase of developing the project site shall be \$300,000.00.
6. That St. Johns County is legally capable and fiscally able to satisfactorily develop, operate and maintain the facility according to program requirements.
- 7.1 That the County of St. Johns, Florida, has an officially adopted Local Comprehensive Plan, including a Recreation and Open Space Element with the public being continuously offered the opportunity to participate in the process.
- 7.2 That the County of St. Johns certifies that the development of this project site will be a positive step in attaining the recreational goals set by the Local Comprehensive Plan for this area in particular and the County over all.
8. That this project is in compliance with and is a step toward fulfillment of the goals of the Local Plan as shown elsewhere in this application.
9. This Resolution shall be in effect as prescribed by law upon its passage.
