SCHEDULE "A"

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A portion of a forty-foot county easement lying between Lots 23 and 26 of Scotts Subdivision, the same being a part of the F. Fatio Grant, Section 39, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, according to map in Deed Book "Y," Page 400, Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida; the said portion of easement lying south of State Road 13, and extending from a point of intersection with the southeasterly right-of-way line of said State Road 13 and running thence in a northeasterly direction, terminating at the northeasterly boundary line of the said Lots 23 and 26, a distance of 320 feet more or less.
