

RESOLUTION NO. 85-190

A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, INCREASING THE FEE FOR WHICH THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FOR PREMARITAL BLOOD TESTING.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance No. 82-2 authorized St. Johns County Health Department to collect reasonable fees, contributions and donations for certain services performed by the Health Department upon approval of such fee by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Public Health Laboratories will be charging \$3.00 for premarital serology testing effective January 1, 1986.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 17 day of December, 1985, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that St. Johns County Resolutions #82-59 is hereby amended by changing the Schedule A fee schedule attached to said resolution to require \$8.00 for a premarital blood test instead of \$5.00.

All other provisions of St. Johns County Resolution 82-59, as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect.

This Resolution shall take effect January 1, 1986.
