PETITION TO VACATE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYWAYS AND ROADS

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA

COMES NOW, NORTH BEACH INVESTMENT, INC., a Florida

Corporation, and respectfully petition this Honorable Board as

follows:

I. To vacate, abandon, discontinue and close those certain public streets, alleyways or roads situate in St. Johns County, Florida, hereinafter more particularly described; to renounce and disclaim any right of St. Johns County and the public in and to the lands constituting such streets, alleyways or roads; and to renounce and disclaim any right of St. Johns County and the public in and to any lands or interests therein acquired by purchase, gift, devise, dedication or prescription for said streets, alleyways or roads; which said streets, alleyways or roads are designated as follows, to wit:

To adopt a resolution declaring that at a definite time and place a public hearing will be held to consider the advisability of the above, and to publish notice as prescribed by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes, one (1) time in a newspaper of general circulation advising of a public hearing in connection with the above matter, and thereafter adopting a resolution renouncing and disclaiming any right of the County and the public in and to the above streets, alleyways or roads, and vacating, abandoning, discontinueing and closing same.

4. Petitioners further show that said streets, alleyways or roads sought to be vacated are neither State nor Federal Highways and are wholly without the limits of any municipality.


