

RESOLUTION NO. 85-77

WHEREAS, St. Johns County suffered a serious threat to the lives of its residents and serious loss of its forests due to the fire, and

WHEREAS, this serious threat and loss were mitigated by the actions of its Volunteer Fire Departments, Florida Forestry Service, St. Johns County Sheriff's Department, American Red Cross, St. Johns County School Board, St. Johns County Rescue Services, Road & Bridge Department, Ham Radio Operators, St. Johns County Emergency Management Office, as well as many citizens who volunteered their services, and

WHEREAS, these agencies and citizens formed a cooperative barrier to prevent further loss and threat to the citizens of St. Johns County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, representing the citizens of St. Johns County, join in offering deep appreciation to all of the parties who participated in stopping the threat and loss of lives and property over the three (3) day period from May 17, 1985, through May 20, 1985.
