A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, APPOINTING THE SALAVATION ARMY
TO SUPERVISE THE COMMUNITY SERVICES OF INDIGENTS
REQUIRED BY THE COURTS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, PUR-
SUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 27.3455

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 27.3455 provides that the Courts of St.
Johns County may require indigent defendants to perform community services
in lieu of paying certain costs prescribed in the statute,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 18 day of June, 1985,
by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that the Salvation
Army is hereby appointed to supervise on behalf of St. Johns County the
community services required under Florida Statute 27.3455 and to receive
from the County such compensation for providing such supervision as the
Salvation Army and the County shall hereafter mutually agree.
