PROCLAMATION  
FIRE PREVENTION WEEK, OCTOBER 5th - 11th, 1986

WHEREAS, The President of the United States has proclaimed October 5th through October 11th, as NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK; and,

WHEREAS, experience has shown that effective County Fire Prevention Programs have saved thousands of lives and millions of dollars to property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, hereby proclaiming the week of October 5th through 11th, 1986, as County-wide Fire Prevention Week. All agencies of the County Government, and particularly the fire departments and schools, are directed and requested to assist in arousing the public to the seriousness of the fire problems. Each citizen is earnestly requested to do his part in eliminating all possible cause of fire in his home or in his business. It is urged that school children of this community be given appropriate instructions to inspect their residence, and that the fire department assist them in their effort.
