## RESOLUTION NO. 86-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 86-119 THAT PROVIDES FOR THE PAVING OF FOURTH STREET UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 76-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has received and accepted the petition of at least 75% of the landowners fronting on the above mentioned street. The residents desire to have Fourth Street paved pursuant to County Ordinance 76-21.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- 1. The petition is hereby accepted and the project is authorized to commence.
- 2. The beginning and ending points are the intersection of Fourth Street and Volusia through the intersection of Fourth Street and Brevard.
- 3. The estimated cost of the project is \$18,000.00.
- 4. The sharing ratio shall be as follows:

  - a) St. Johns County one third of the cost.b) The balance to be paid by the Strength for Living
- 5. The preliminary assessment rate is \$12,000.00.
- 6. Payment shall be made in one payment due upon completion of the construction.
