

RESOLUTION 86- 139

A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, IDENTIFYING SPECIFIC SERVICES FOR WHICH THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FEES AND SETTING SUCH FEES.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance #82-2 as amended, authorizes the St. Johns County Health Department to collect reasonable fees, contributions and donations for certain services performed by the Health Department upon approval of such fee by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida considered the fee and services set forth in the attached Schedule A and attachment I and determined that they are fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14 day of October, 1986, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that commencing October 14, 1986, the St. Johns County Health Department shall charge pursuant to St. Johns County Ordinance #82-2, as amended, the fees set forth in the attached Schedule A and attachment I for the services indicated therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Health Department shall cause the funds derived from such fees to be deposited promptly into the special revenue fund described in St. Johns County County Ordinance #82-2, and said funds shall be used as provided in said Ordinance, but only after the expenditures have been approved by the Board of County Commissioners when such prior approval is required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all prior resolutions establishing fees under and pursuant to Ordinance #82-2, as amended, are hereby terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is requested to file a copy of this Resolution and a copy of St. Johns County Ordinance #82-2, as amended, with the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services.

Bar or Lounge - same as above, including any facility operating with any COP Beverage License.	
Food Processing Plant - Commercial building or establishment in which food is processed or otherwise prepared and packaged for human consumption.	50.00
Group Care Facilities including Nursing Homes.	50.00
Community, Non-Community, and Other Public Water Systems	50.00
Ice Plants	50.00
Sewage Treatment Plant	50.00
Food Outlet - Any grocery store, food market, meat market, fruit or vegetable market, food warehouse, refrigerated storage facility, freezer locker, and any other place storing or offering food for sale.	40.00
Abattoir - Any establishment in which animals are slaughtered or where meat processing, canning, curing, smoking, salting, rendering, or other similar operations take place.	30.00
When multiple services are provided at one time to the same parcel of real estate then only one fee shall be charged and said fee shall be the highest fee applicable.	
Beverage Department Forms - Premises Inspections if no inspection has been performed in the past 60 days.	<u>25.00</u>
Show, (carnival, circus) with Food Service Operations and Temporary Food Service operation.	50.00/4 days
Rat Poison - per bag.	.50
Copies - per page	1.00
Well Construction Permit	25.00

All Permits expire one year from date of issue, unless construction has begun.

All annual service fees expire on September 30 of each year, (regardless of when purchased).

Annual service fees are due and payable within 30 days of billing, at the St. Johns County Public Health Unit, 180 Marine St., St. Augustine.

No county fee shall be charged governmental agencies located within St. Johns County.

All annual fee services shall be prorated for new facilities as follows:

If approved for opening and/or operation between October and March 31 at 100%.

If approved for opening and/or operation between April 1 and July 31 at 50%.

Fees collected from August 1 thru September 30, are valid thru September 30 of the next year.
