RESOLUTION 86-144

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA APPROVING FINAL ASSESSMENTS FOR PAVING OF CENTURY BOULEVARD UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 76-21. AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has considered the establishment of the final assessment amounts for paving of Century Boulevard at a public hearing duly noticed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- 1. The assessments prepared by the County Administrator as presented at this hearing, a copy of which is attached hereto, are approved, with each assessment being divided into five equal annual installments, with interest on the unpaid amount added at 9% per annum. The interest shall commence to accrue on April 1, 1987.
 - Installments may be paid in advance, without interest or penalty.
- 3. The Notice of Lien shall be prepared by the Clerk of Courts listing the name and address of each property owner at the top, and in its body listing the name, legal description, assessment amount for each piece of property, the number of annual installment, and the interest rate.
- 4. The Notice of Lien shall be recorded by the Clerk of the Board in a special book to be known as the "Road Improvement Lien Book" and also in the Official Public Records of St. Johns County.
- The first installment shall become due with the tax bills due April 1, 1988 mailed on or about November 1, 1987.
- 6. Principal and accrued interest may be prepaid at any time without penalty.
- 7. A copy of this resolution shall be delivered to the Clerk of the Courts, the Tax Collector and the Property Appraiser.
- 8. The Clerk shall make sure that a notice of the final assessment amount and appropriate billings are mailed to the property owners.
