## RESOLUTION 86-148

WHEREAS, the August 9, 1909 plat titled "Map of Riverdale Land Company" was recorded in Map Book 1, pages 148,149,150,151,152,and 153 in the records of St. Johns County, Florida as a named subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the subdivision plats showed certain roads, streets and a public park. The public park and existing boat ramp have been continuously operated and maintained by St. Johns County for a period in excess of forty

WHEREAS, siltation of the boat ramp now requires that the County remove the accumulated silt in order to continue to operate the public boat ramp, the only public access to the St. Johns River south of Palmo road, approximately 15 miles away.

WHEREAS, The Park existed long before the State initiated charges for dredge material, and the spoil removed is not being used for fill on the upland area of the park.

WHEREAS, The County has applied to the Department of Environmental Regulation for a permit to remove the accumulated spoil under File No. 551222402.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

The St. Johns County Commission Petitions the State of Florida, Department of Natural Resources to waive the \$2.25 per cubic yard fee for removal of silt from the boat channel at the County park in Riverdale.
