A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF OAK AND PINE LANES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 76-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has received and accepted the petition of at least 75% of the landowners fronting on the abovementioned streets, to have the roads paved pursuant to County Ordinance 76-21,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- 1. The petition is hereby accepted and the project is authorized to commence.
- 2. The beginning and ending points are the intersection of Oak Lane and Wildwood Dr. through the cul-de sac at the end of Oak Lane, and from the intersection of Oak Lane and Pine Lane through the cul-de sac at the end of Pine Lane.
 - 3. The cost of the project shall not exceed \$67,126.00
- 4. The sharing ratio shall be 1/3 of the basic road cost paid by the County, and the balance (including 100% of the additional cost for provision of planters) to be paid by the abutting landowners based on their proportionate share of equivalent road length.
- 5. The preliminary assessment rate shall be \$6.00 per equivalent abutting foot for the basic road, plus \$0.57 per equivalent abutting foot for provision of planters.
 - 6. The interest rate shall be 9.0 percent per annum.
 - 7. The term of payment shall be five years with 20% plus interest due each annual payment.
- 8. Payments shall commence with the tax bill due April 1, 1987, as mailed on or about November 1, 1986.
