

RESOLUTION 86-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FLORIDA REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONTACT THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD TO DEVELOP A BRIDGE OPENING SCHEDULE FOR THE VILANO BEACH BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, vehicular traffic on AIA must cross the Vilano Beach Bridge going to and from the Mainland; and,

WHEREAS, the Vilano Bridge is a lift bridge to accommodate boat traffic; and,

WHEREAS, there has been a significant increase in boat traffic on the Intra-coastal Waterway, as well as a large marina adjacent to the Causeway; and

WHEREAS, this increase in boat traffic seriously impedes the flow of vehicular traffic by causing frequent bridge openings; and,

WHEREAS, the Bridge of Lions is located only two (2) miles south of the Vilano Bridge and is opened only on the half hour;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 7th day of January, 1986, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County to request the Florida Department of Transportation to contact the United States Coast Guard to schedule these bridge openings to coordinate or coincide with the current openings of the Bridge of Lions during daylight hours.
