- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that May 4 10, 1986 is hereby proclaimed St.Johns County Teacher Appreciation Week for the purpose of providing public recognition and appreciation for the dedication and contributions of the classroom teacher, not only to this community as a whole, but to each of us as individual citizens.
