WHEREAS, the State Comprehensive Plan (Zwick) Committee has determined that local governments in Florida have an \$18 billion unmet need to fund new growth through the year 2000 and,


WHEREAS, the State Legislature made a policy decision in 1985, reaffirmed that decision in 1986 and effective 1987, that infrastructure must be in place before development can be permitted and,

WHEREAS, there is a statewide shortage of criminal justice facilities and adequacy of inmate capacities and,

WHEREAS, these situations place a severe capital burden on local governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 26 day of May, 1987 that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County support local option one cent (.01¢) sales tax legislation without mandatory referendum.
