

RESOLUTION NO. 87-108

WHEREAS, the Julington-Durbin Creeks Peninsula parcel, #15 on present CARL list, has been on the list for five years due to lack of funding; and,

WHEREAS, the explosive population directly north of parcel and the rapid growth pattern set in motion by General Development Corporation's Julington Creek project south of parcel have placed immediate development demands on this sensitive parcel; and,

WHEREAS, development would create unnecessary environmental burdens on these important tributaries to the St. Johns River; and,

WHEREAS, the general public and those citizens within the nearby community enthusiastically support this purchase; and,

WHEREAS, this parcel will contribute much needed open space for passive recreational use - camping, hiking, riding, birding, etc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, continues to enthusiastically support state purchase as quickly as possible, of the Julington-Durbin Creeks Peninsula parcel.
