RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS, ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Vilano Beach Investments, Inc., as Owner, has tendered a drainage easement dated May 20, 1987, to the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, conveying to the County an easement for a drainage system,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the above described easement is hereby accepted by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida. This acceptance shall not be deemed an acceptance requiring construction or maintenance of the drainage system.

The Clerk is instructed to record the drainage easement at the County's expense.

GRANT OF DRAINAGE EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, Vilano Beach Investments, Inc., hereinafter called GRANTOR, for \$10.00 and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby and by these presents assign, convey, remise, release and grant unto St. Johns County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is c/o Clerk of Courts, St. Johns County Courthouse, St. Augustine, Florida 32084, and to its assigns, hereinafter called GRANTEE, a perpetual exclusive easement to construct and maintain all or part of a drainage system over, under and across the following parcel of real property in St. Johns County, Florida, to wit:

The East 10 feet of Lot 20, Block 26, and the West 10 feet of Lot 21, Block 26, Clarks Addition to St. Augustine, recorded in Map Book 1, page 77, of the current public records of St. Johns County, Florida (Property).

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the grantee, its successors and assigns for the above described purposes forever.

"Grantor" and "Grantee" are used for singular or plural, as context requires.
