

RESOLUTION NO. 87-12

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE DESIGNATION OF AN ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE REGULATIONS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 76-18, AND ITS AMENDMENTS, PERTAINING TO ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY, AND EXCLUDING ANY INCORPORATED TOWN OR CITY IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, By virtue of the powers conferred under Chapter 125, Section 125.01 and Chapter 403, Florida Statutes as amended, and by St. Johns County Ordinance 76-18, this Board is authorized and empowered by resolution to establish and redesignate an enforcement agency (Environmental Inspector) for the enforcement and regulation of the provisions contained in St. Johns County Ordinance 76-18 and its amendments thereto, and

WHEREAS, it is believed to be in the best interest and in order to protect the health and welfare of the citizens of St. Johns County, excluding any incorporated town or city located within St. Johns County, exercise the authority granted to the Board of County Commissioners under Chapter 125, Section 125.01 and Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and under St. Johns County Ordinance 76-18 establish and designate the St. Johns County Health Department and its duly authorized Health Inspector to enforce and regulate the provisions of St. Johns County Ordinance 76-18 and its amendments.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 27 day of January, 1987, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the St. Johns County Health Department and its duly authorized Health Inspector is hereby designated as Environmental Inspector to enforce and regulate St. Johns County Ordinance 76-18 as amended.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon its passage.
