A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ACCEPTING FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR ANTICIPATED EXPENSES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A REQUIRED TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON COUNTY ROAD A-1-A.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance 86-4 as ammended requires the installation of traffic signal for commercial developments having more than 300 parking spaces, and

WHEREAS, Romano Development, Inc. has applied for a driveway permit for its project fronting on County Road A-1-A, and

- The staff is hereby authorized to issue the driveway permit and proceed with final design and installation of the signal.
