

RESOLUTION 87-183

A RESOLUTION OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SUPPORTING REQUEST OF SUMMERHAVEN PROPERTY OWNERS TO REOPEN A CHANNEL IN THE MATANZAS RIVER.

WHEREAS, property owners of Summerhaven have applied for and received a construction permit from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Regulation; and

WHEREAS, the construction permit authorized the applicant to dredge and reopen a channel in the Matanzas River approximately 2,500 linear feet in length with a bottom width of 30 feet and a depth of minus five (-5) feet mean low water; and

WHEREAS, the dredged material will be placed on the beach area seaward of the coastal construction control line;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County supports Summerhaven property owners request to dredge and reopen a channel in the Matanzas River and placing the dredged material on the adjacent beach.
