

RESOLUTION 87-187

AUTHORIZING ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE "REGIONAL SOLID WASTE FEASIBILITY STUDY"

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1987 the Governors Energy Office began requesting proposals for "Technical Assistance to Local and Regional Governments for Solid Waste Feasibility Studies"; and

WHEREAS, this grant money will be used to investigate the feasibility of innovative solid waste management techniques that save energy and or produce renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, participation in this program will award up to \$20,000 in grant money per local government and require a minimum of \$5,000 in matching funds per local government; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council as lead agency will combine funds from all participating counties in it's region and produce a "Regional Solid Waste Feasibility Study"; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County in addition to all counties in the Northeast Florida Region needs to find better methods for solid waste disposal and will greatly benefit from this study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Commission respectfully request participation along with the other counties in Northeast Florida in the solid waste feasibility study to be administered by the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council.
