

RESOLUTION NO. 87-205

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has received the County Public Health Unit Contract from the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has and continues to experience phenomenal growth, and

WHEREAS, this continued growth has created a recognizable need for competent expertise in the supervision and overseeing of a wide range of medical services which are beyond the capabilities of the present staff of St. Johns County, and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has a need for the services of a Medical Director to oversee certain medical services,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the County Public Health Unit Contract be revised as follows:

1. General Provisions - Add paragraph C as follows:

To provide services for the County in the capacity of Medical Director such as; Detention Center Medical Services, Rescue Services, and other health related services that the county may designate.

2. Special Provisions - Attachment 1, new section K, reading as follows:

The County Public Health Unit Director will serve as the Medical Director for St. Johns County and perform functions such as those identified in General Provisions, Section C.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in view of the additional responsibilities and demands placed upon the County Public Health Unit Director, that if approved, consideration be given by the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services to increasing the salary of the County Public Health Unit Director to the maximum of that pay range.
