

RESOLUTION No. 87-214

WHEREAS, the existing posted speed limit on AIA in St. Augustine Beach is 40 MPH and this road is county-maintained and the City Commission has requested through Marshall A.M. Bandy that this speed limit be reviewed for current applicability; and

WHEREAS, State Law (Sec 316.189, F.S.) says that the speed limit in this instance is 30 mph, but that the limit may be altered by the County Commission after investigation determines such a change is reasonable; and

WHEREAS, this stretch of County road is just over two miles of two lane, heavily traveled roadway with multiple unsignalled intersections and varying right-of-way widths and parking on shoulder and on wider sections of r.o.w. is prevalent; and

WHEREAS, there are in excess of fifty intersections or driveways where cars can enter the roadway, and the traffic load is bound to grow with the scheduled completion of Anastasia Plaza this year

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

The speed limit on AIA within the town limits of St. Augustine Beach, from Pope Road to Versaggi Road is hereby reduced to 30 mph and that the Road and Bridge Dept. of St. Johns County is directed to post speed limits accordingly.
