

RESOLUTION NO. 87- 248

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is a leader in the growth of the Florida First Coast Area and intends to benefit from its continued development by the innovative application of proven methods to guide and support that growth, and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners is acutely aware that such growth places substantial pressure upon county government to provide facilities for essential services such as water and sewerage, and

WHEREAS, the Commission recognizes that provision of water and sewerage services is most economical to future users of utilities when those facilities are Master-Planned to serve large areas and their operations are administered by competent entities which can achieve economies of scale, and


WHEREAS, Sunray Utilities, Inc. has indicated its willingness and intent to assume the responsibility of providing water and sewerage services available to the Greater St. Johns Forest Region of St. Johns County (lands owned or previously owned by Rayland Corporation) by private investment and further, to Master-Plan the area to achieve economies of scale and provide efficient and effective management of operations, and

WHEREAS, the approval of the St. Johns County Commission of such intents of Sunray Utilities, Inc. can lend support to their applications for proper authorities to create such facilities and furnish such services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Commission has reviewed the plans and knows the capabilities of ITT Rayonier, parent company of Sunray Utilities, Inc. and hereby supports its applications to create and furnish water and sewerage services to the approximate 21,650 acres of the Greater St. Johns Forest region of St. Johns County for the benefit of its present and future residents.
