

RESOLUTION 87-251

WHEREAS, Jacksonville has continued to pursue the landfill site that borders on the County of St. Johns; and,

WHEREAS, we have verbally talked and handed to the elected officials of Jacksonville our concerns of this area; and,

WHEREAS, these concerns have not been answered to the satisfaction of this Commission; and,

WHEREAS, this plan does not fit the Comprehensive Plan of St. Johns County; and,

WHEREAS, the landfill site is still one mile from a major Junior-Senior High School of St. Johns County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners requests our Legislative Delegation to file an Act in the Legislature specifying that any landfill siting within two miles of another county falls under the DRI classification.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that St. Johns County does inform Duval County that we are still against the location of the landfill, and ask that they consider other alternatives, and again we offer our assistance to that end.
