

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 13-19, 1987,  
AS DRUNK AND DRUGGED DRIVING AWARENESS WEEK IN THE COUNTY  
OF ST. JOHNS

WHEREAS, driving under the influence (DUI) of alcohol or controlled substances contributes significantly to fatalities and injuries each year on ST. JOHNS County's highways; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida is providing assistance to local governments in the development of community-based traffic safety programs with DUI emphasis; and

WHEREAS, citizen advocacy groups, such as Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), Students Against Driving Drunk (SADD), Remove Intoxicated Drivers (RID), and Boost Alcohol Consciousness Concerning the Health of University Students (BACCHUS) are increasing their efforts to reduce the incidence of driving under the influence in Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that each citizen become more keenly aware of and knowledgeable concerning the problem of driving under the influence and the penalties that are imposed under Florida's DUI law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the week of December 13-19, 1987, shall be designated as

DRUNK AND DRUGGED DRIVING AWARENESS WEEK

in ST. JOHNS County and all citizens are urged to become more cognizant of the intoxicated driver problem and to support efforts within the County to reduce the incidence of driving under the influence.
