RESOLUTION NO. 87-70

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation has been requested by St. Johns County to grant permits for grade crossings of Florida East Coast railroad lines at the following locations:

- EXTENSION OF S.R. 312 NEAR DOBBS ROAD
- EXTENSION OF LEWIS POINT ROAD TO INDUSTRIAL PARK ROAD
- EXTENSION OF WILDWOOD DR. TO C.R. 214 IN SECTION 55, and

WHEREAS, the construction and maintenance of these crossings must be guaranteed to meet D.O.T. standards prior to issuing permits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby agrees that any construction of the crossings by St. Johns County will comply with the Department of Transportation standards, and in conformance with all requirements of the permits.

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER that St. Johns County hereby agrees to be responsible for maintenance of the Roadway and Shoulders crossing the tracks, the Crossing Signals and Gates, and all appurtenances installed by St. Johns County pursuant to the permits.
